Turun Metsänkävijät 100 years

The Scouting activities of the TuMe began on 4 April 1925. The orienteering club was only founded in 1962, so the focus of the anniversary year is on the Scouting side.

However, to celebrate the anniversary, the club is organizing a national sprint orienteering competition and two precision orienteering competitions in Impivaara, Turku, on 13–14 September. Mark the dates in your calendar. Everyone is needed to help out then.

At the same time, the Scouts will organize an old-fashioned triathlon competition (cross-country running, shooting and map reading).

In addition, the Turku Street-O season will end with a jubilee theme, where all 30 checkpoints are related in one way or another to the history of the TuMe. The Scouts' summer camp will also have an orienteering theme day.



New warehouse

Membership fees

The club's membership fee will be paid as in previous years and at the following prices: adults €20, those who have signed a representation agreement €10, children and young people (under 20 years old) €5 and family fee (living in the same household) €30.

The due date is Friday, January 31, 2025.

If you want to compete in SSL competitions, please remember to obtain a license.

Rules of the entry fees

The club pays entry fees for the IOF/SSL competitions held in Finland and for one domestic control week during the year. This requires paying the club membership fee and actively participating in the club's activities.

If a competition has multiple payment thresholds, the club only pays for the lowest one. Late registrations on your own expense.

The competition disciplines are FootO, SkiO, MTBO and TrailO. The club pays for participation in one domestic rogaining competition during the year and, in addition, in accordance with the practice of previous years, the Turku Rogaining Sprint competitions. The club does not pay for participation in various adventure competitions or hobby and training events, such as indoor orienteering.

Members have the right to participate in Turku area AV group trainings and Turku Street-O free of charge.

Chairman Mikko will answer inquiries if necessary.

Nordic walkers have done 8 runs during the autumn, a total of 134 km walked, the average length of the runs has been 16.8 km. The pace has been brisk, on forest roads about 8.50-9.10 min/km.
